



Biogas Plant Heiligengrabe - Electricity Fed into Grid

Doric is pleased to announce that the first engine was commissioned at the Biogas Plant Heiligengrabe at 12.30 on 8th October 2009, feeding electricity into the local grid for the first time.

It is expected that revenue will start to be received from the energy supply company E.ON edis in November 2009 .

From now on output of the engines will gradually be increased. By the end of October 2009 the first engine will be running at full capacity, 844 kWel. Two more engines (with outputs of 844 kWel and 365 kWel) are expected to be running at full capacity by year-end.
